Emergency Alert System Requires Registration For Some Users

Did you know the City of Lebanon uses CodeRED alert system that relays information to residents by phone?

In the event of a non-weather emergency or other important event, the high-speed messaging system can deliver customized emergency notification and instructions at a rate of 60,000 calls per hour. Residential land line telephones automatically receive CodeRED messages, however you must register if you wish to receive the emergency notifications.

Please register if:

- You want to be notified on your cell phone
- You have an unlisted phone number
- You have recently moved and need to update your phone number
- You use TDD/TTY
- You want to use your work phone as a back up to your home phone
