Ordinance 2013-035 - Approving supplemental appropriations in the General Fund (\$60.0k) and the Parks and Recreation Impact Fee Fund (\$2.0k) to support the refunding of impact fees paid after June 22, 2010, with emergency language. - d. Ordinance - Approving updates to Chapter 133.02 of the Codified Ordinances by deleting the MSW Crew Leader, and the MSW I, II, and III position titles, and adding the Parks MSW Crew Leader, Streets MSW Crew Leader, Parks MSW I, II, and III, and the Streets MSW I, II, and III position titles.

Ordinance - Approving a supplemental appropriation in the Sewer Fund, \$64.0k, to reimburse the Warren County Port Authority for a portion of the design costs for the JEDD sanitary sewer construction project as approved by Ordinance 2012-101, adopted Dec 11, 2012.
