The work generally consists of the construction of modifications and improvements to existing facilities at the wastewater treatment plant as follows: (1) Demolition of existing UV system components including, but not limited to, UV banks and control panel; (2) Furnishing and installing new UV system and controls (Trojan); (3) Modifications to existing channels; (4) Modifications to existing grating and installation of new grating; (5) All associated electrical/control work; (6) Other miscellaneous items of work.
