On 8/16/13 at approximately 1131 hours I responded to 555 N. Broadway for a private property hit/skip accident. The complainant, Jeremy Smith, is a delivery driver for Red Bull energy drinks and had just completed at delivery to the Shriners Quick Mart. Mr. Smith stated he was waiting to enter the lane of traffic on Broadway when he felt a bump from behind. Mr. Smith then noticed a red Chevrolet Cavalier, Ohio registration FLM 7982, pull around him and leave the scene. The right passenger side bumper of the Cavalier was damaged. Mr. Smith was able to provide dispatch with the registration and direction of travel.

After obtaining the necessary information from Mr. Smith I then attempted to locate the suspect vehicle. The registered owner, Douglas Conover, had an address of 201 Miller Road #75. Upon checking the address I found the red Chevrolet Cavalier backed in to a parking space as to avoid seeing the rear bumper. I walked around the car and found the damage consistent with that of the reported accident. The vehicles hood felt warm as if the vehicle had just been parked. I knocked on the apartment door repeatedly and no one ever came out. I left a business card in the door for Mr. Conover to call me.

On 8/17/13 I returned to duty and had two voicemails from Mr. Conover. I called the subject and he denied being the driver stating he was at work the entire time. I stressed to Mr. Conover he needed to come to the police department and bring proof of insurance and his registration. At approximately 0930 hours the subject arrived and we discussed the incident. Mr. Conover was insistent he was not the driver, that he lives alone, and did not allow anyone to drive the car. This interview continued on for a few more minutes. Ultimately I told Mr. Conover I would need his employer's information so I could call and verify his whereabouts the time of the crash. Mr. Conover kept saying, "Just give me the ticket I didnt do it but I will take responsibility." I told him I could not do that and I would investigate the matter more next week.

Approximately 45 minutes later Mr. Conover came back to the police department with his 16 year old son, Chase Conover, who has only a temporary permit. Mr. Conover explained his son had stopped by the apartment and took the car without his permission. The juvenile drove it to the carry out to buy a Gatorade and when he bumped the delivery truck, "freaked out", and took off.

I asked Chase if this was in fact what happened and he said, "Yeah I got scared and took off." The juvenile was issued a citation for Stopping After Accidents ORD. 335.13 and Driving With a Permit W/out a Licensed Driver ORD. 335.03. This offense occurred in the City of Lebanon, Warren County, State of Ohio.
